SUBJECT: Attempted Robbery Howard Johnsons

The Newark Police Department is investigating an attempted armed robbery that occurred on 5/21/11 at 10:53pm at the Howard Johnsons Hotel located at 1119 South College Avenue. During this incident the suspect entered the lobby, pointed a small black handgun at the clerk and demanded money. The clerk then retreated into a back office and the suspect left the lobby without receiving any money.

The suspect is described as a thin, light skinned black male, approximately 5'8" to 6'1" tall, wearing a dark colored hooded sweatshirt with the hood up and a white scarf covering his face. The suspect was also wearing white socks over his hands and had an unknown dark colored apron or shirt draped around his waist.

The suspect was last seen fleeing into an interior hallway for the Howard Johnsons.
