### **HOLIDAY REFUSE COLLECTION CHANGES**

Due to the Christmas Day holiday, recycling normally collected on Thursday, December 23 will be collected on Wednesday, December 22. Recycling normally collected on Friday, December 24 will be collected on Thursday, December 23.

The last "Green Wednesday" yard waste collection will be Wednesday, December 1 and will return on Wednesday, March 2, 2022. The City will have scheduled collections during this time. Please call (302) 366-7000 to schedule. Carts will only be collected if scheduled.

The Leaf Collection Program will continue through Thursday, December 30, 2021. All leaves must be raked to the grassy plot between the curb and the sidewalk by Friday, December 24, 2021.

Christmas trees will be collected beginning Monday, December 27, 2021 and continue through Friday, January 28, 2022. Crews will sweep the entire City once per week during this time. Please make sure trees are out for collection each week by Monday at 7 a.m.

Trees will not be collected after January 28, 2022.
