

## WEEKLY REPORT

On Tuesday, December 22<sup>nd</sup> at 4:50 a.m., officers responded to a report of a one-vehicle accident on Library Avenue. Upon arriving at the scene, the officers found a vehicle off to the side of the road with body damage. The vehicle was occupied by the driver and five passengers. All were arrested for underage consumption of alcohol. The driver was also charged with Driving Under the Influence. One passenger was also wanted on three active capiases.

On Thursday, December 24<sup>th</sup>, at 7:50 a.m., an employee of the Christina Mill apartment complex arrived at work to discover that a 40-inch flat screen television was stolen from the leasing office. All doors and windows were locked and there was no sign of forced entry.
