

WEEKLY REPORT

On Sunday, April 4th, at 1:30 a.m., Newark Police responded to a call of a man that attempted to break into a house on East Cleveland Avenue. The suspect was arrested and charged with attempted burglary, possession of burglary tools, carrying a deadly weapon, and criminal mischief.

On Thursday, April 8th, members of the Newark Police Department and the University of Delaware Police Department participated in Crowd Control Training under the instruction of the Delaware State Police. This is the second year of this training, which takes place in anticipation of Chapelfest.

On Monday, April 12th, at 2:34 a.m., Officer Barnes came upon a 41-year-old female at the corner of Old Oak Road and Sypherd Drive. The female stated she left the Deer Park Tavern with a male she met there. After driving in the suspect's vehicle, the suspect pulled to the side of the road and raped the female. Following the assault, the suspect pushed the victim out of the car and drove off.

On Tuesday, April 13th, Chief Tiernan and Lt. Stanko attended a public meeting with the Delaware Department of Transportation concerning the toll construction on Rte. 95. During peak construction, traffic lanes on Rte. 95 will be reduced to seven lanes in each direction instead of the current ten lanes in each direction. As a result, this will increase local traffic in Newark.

On Wednesday, April 14th, Chief Tiernan and members of the administrative staff travelled to the East Orange, New Jersey Police Department to review the closed circuit security camera system.

Cleveland Avenue landlords and the Newark Police Department have sent letters to all Chapel Street residents advising them of the consequences of illegal activity resulting from Chapelfest. Next week Chief Tiernan and Captain Williams will go door to door and speak to each resident of Chapel Street to discuss any concerns.
