**Summary:**

On 04/22/2010 Newark Police responded to the report of a suspicious package that was discovered in the men's bathroom at the Boston Market Restaurant located at 1050 South College Ave. After the device had been located by an employee the employee took it to the parking lot and notified his manager. The manager then notified the police who responded and evacuated the area.

The Newark Police requested the assistance of the Delaware State Police Explosive Ordinance Disposal Unit who responded and rendered the device safe. After a visual examination the device is believed to have been a hoax and not an actual explosive.

The Newark Police will continue to investigate this incident to determine who might have placed the device in the restaurant.
