SUBJECT: Naked Swim at Apartment Pool Brings Charges

The defendant, Dean Rissler, was swimming at the Pine Brook Apartments pool around 1:45 p.m. on Monday July 26, 2010, when the 17 year-old female life guard noticed Rissler was naked in the pool. The lifeguard informed Rissler that he had to put his swim trunks back on.

Rissler complied, but about five minutes later, the guard noticed Rissler in the water with his back to the pool wall and his arms on the ledge. His bathing suit was sitting on the edge of the pool. Rissler then began raising his legs, causing his genitals to be exposed atop the water. His actions were seen by both the lifeguard and a 25 year-old female who was a patron of the pool. Rissler again complied when instructed to put on his bathing suit.

Police were contacted and Rissler was taken into custody without incident. He was charged with two count of Indecent Exposure 2^{nd} Degree. After an initial court appearance, he was released on an unsecured bail of \$1,000.
