WEEKLY REPORT 08/08-08/14/10

On Monday, August 16th at 11:52 a.m., Officer James Spadola checked the registration of a vehicle parked on South College Avenue to find the license plate on the car was reported as stolen in New Castle County. Officer Spadola observed the vehicle until a male approached it and opened the trunk. The officer questioned the owner of the vehicle who admitted stealing the license plate and placing it on his vehicle. The suspect was arrested and issued a summons to appear in court.

On Monday, August 16th at 4:00 p.m., members of the Newark Police Department Street Crime Unit conducted a motor vehicle stop in the Newark Shopping Center. The officers detected an order of marijuana in the vehicle. A search of the vehicle recovered, 76 grams of marijuana, 16 doses of Ecstasy, and drug paraphernalia.

This past weekend the Traffic Bureau began conducting evening road and seatbelt safety checks in the downtown area. These checks will continue through the first week of September.

Beginning on Friday, August 20th, the Newark Police 2010 Fall Crime Suppression Plan will be implemented. Newark Police Department officers along with University of Delaware police officers will be located in concentrated patrol zones in areas surrounding the university campus and off campus housing areas. Officers will be patrolling in both marked and unmarked vehicles, as well as on foot. This is the third year of our Fall Crime Suppression Plan. As a result of this initiative, since its implementation two years prior the department has seen a significant reduction in street crime. The City of Newark has seen 6 less robberies this year to date, compared to this date last year.

The Newark Police Department has been awarded a \$45,000 grant from the Department of Justice. The grant will pay for two additional surveillance cameras and a "fixed location" automatic license plate reader. The "reader" automatically checks vehicle registrations to see if the vehicle has been reported stolen or wanted.
