**SUBJECT: TD Bank Robbery** 

On Monday February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2011 at 8:47 am the TD Bank, located at 230 East Delaware Avenue, Newark was robbed by a male subject who presented a note demanding money and implying that he had a gun. After receiving an undisclosed amount of currency the suspect fled the bank possibly operating the below described vehicle.

The suspect was described as a white male, 45-55 years old, approximately 6' tall and unshaven, wearing a black hooded jacket, dark gloves, tan fisherman's hat, grey sweat pants, white shoes, and eve glasses. He was carrying a red or pink bag.

The possible suspect vehicle is described as a 1997-2004 2 door white Dodge Dakota pickup displaying a white rear license plate and an American flag sticker on the rear tailgate.
