**SUBJECT: 7-11 Robbery**

On Thursday March 10, 2011 at approximately 11:00 p.m. the Newark Police responded to the 7-11 located at 202 Elkton Road for a report of a robbery. The victim clerk told officers that the suspect entered the store and walked down one of the aisles. The suspect grabbed an item off the shelf and walked up to the register area. As the clerk told the suspect the total price for the item, the suspect demanded the money from the register and implied that he had a gun, although one was not displayed. The clerk handed the suspect an undisclosed amount of cash and then the suspect fled out of the store.

The suspect is described as a white male, 5'06" to 5'08", overweight, partially bald, wearing a blue jeans and a red hoodie.

There are no surveillance photos at this time.
