Updated Information: Victoria Court Home Invasion Robbery

SUBJECT: Home Invasion Robbery

A home invasion style armed robbery occurred at a residence in the 100 block of Victoria Court on Thursday, March 17th, 2011 at approximately 9:21pm. During this incident, three suspects all armed with handguns entered into the residence via an unlocked door. Once inside they confronted two victims in a first floor family room and then two of the suspects proceeded to a second floor bedroom where they confronted a third victim. The suspects fled the residence after removing cell phones, wallets and personal computers.

Following the robbery one of the victims entered his vehicle and attempted to follow the suspects who were observed fleeing the area in a gold Dodge Stratus, possibly with PA tags operated by a white female. As the victim followed the suspect vehicle the suspects jumped from the vehicle and fled on foot, leaving the white female operator in the vehicle. The victim discontinued following the vehicle at this time.

None of the three victims were injured during this incident.

- Suspect 1: Black Male, 18-22 years old, wearing maroon hooded sweatshirt
- Suspect 2: Black Male, 18-22 years old, wearing dark colored hooded sweatshirt
- Suspect 3: Unk race Male, 18-22 years old, wearing dark colored hooded sweatshirt with light colored bandana covering face
- Suspect 4: White Female, 18-22 years old with blond hair

Suspect Vehicle: Gold Dodge Stratus, possible PA Registration
