SUBJECT: Trafficking Cocaine Arrest

The Newark Police have arrested Stephan Black, a 19 year old Newark High School student, after he was found in possession of 82 “rocks” of crack cocaine while in the high school.

The arrest was made at approximately 8:30am on April 7th by the School Resource Officer after he received information that Black was engaged in the sale of a small amount of marijuana to a 17 year old student. During his investigation the School Resource Officer contacted Black and discovered that he was in possession of the crack cocaine. Black was arrested on the below charges and committed to Howard Young Correctional in lieu of \$65,000 secured bail.

The 17 year old juvenile was charged with Possession of Marijuana and released to his parents. There is no indication that any crack cocaine was sold at the high school.

Charges:

- **Trafficking Cocaine**
- **Possession of a Narcotic Schedule II Controlled Substance within 1000’ of school**
- **Distribution, Delivery or Possession of Controlled Substance within 300’ of a Park**
- **Possession of Drug Paraphernalia**
- **Delivery of a Non Narcotic Schedule I Controlled Substance**
- **Possession with Intent to Deliver a Narcotic Schedule II Controlled Substance**

The Newark Police Department affirms that all defendants are presumed innocent until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt.
