

## WEEKLY REPORT

There have been several daytime burglaries throughout the city. On November 7<sup>th</sup>, unknown suspect(s) entered a residence on Hayden Way. Jewelry and a silver serving platter, with a combined value over \$2,000 was stolen. There was no sign of forced entry. On the same day unknown suspect(s) entered a residence on Tanglewood Lane by reaching through a dog door located on a rear door and unlocking the door. Approximately \$500.00 worth of jewelry was taken. On November 8<sup>th</sup>, unknown suspect(s) entered a residence on Odessa Way by breaking a basement window. Approximately \$30,000 worth of jewelry was stolen.

The Newark Police Department has increased patrols in residential areas. Newark Police detectives are meeting with police from surrounding communities who have also experienced a sudden increase in daytime burglaries. Residents are encouraged to notify neighbors when they are out of the house and to report all suspicious persons and activity to the police.

The majority of the police department will be working Saturday, November 12<sup>th</sup>, for the University of Delaware's annual homecoming day. As always, numerous arrests are expected to be made.
