**SUBJECT: Two Arrested For Residential Burglaries**

The Newark Police have arrested two individuals for recent residential burglaries within the City of Newark. These two individuals are not known to each other and the burglaries are not connected.

On January 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2011 Charles Hymer of Newark was arrested for a December 14<sup>th</sup> residential burglary in the unit block of Thompson Circle. Hymer was connected to this burglary after he was stopped by Elkton Police Department on December 15<sup>th</sup>, 2011 for an unrelated incident and found in possession of stolen property linking him to the Thompson Circle burglary.

**Charges:** Burglary 2<sup>nd</sup>  
Theft over \$1500  
Criminal Mischief under \$1000  
\*Committed to Howard R. Young Correctional in lieu of \$3250 bail.

Also arrested on January 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2011 was John T. Steinbeiser of Newark. Following a lengthy investigation Steinbeiser was connected to five residential daytime burglaries which occurred in the neighborhood of Ridgewood Glen between September and December, 2011.

**Charges:** 5 counts Burglary 2<sup>nd</sup>  
5 counts Theft over \$1500  
3 counts Criminal Mischief under \$1000  
\*Committed to Howard R. Young Correctional in lieu of \$7,800 bail.
