## SUBJECT: Newark Man Charged with Residential Burglary

Newark Police have arrested 19 year old Zachary Brady of Newark for a residential burglary of an unoccupied home in the 800 block of Kenyon Lane, which occurred on April 26<sup>th</sup>, 2013.

The homeowners reported the incident to Newark Police on April 27<sup>th</sup>, 2013 after discovering that several items including a handgun were stolen from the home while they were away. Detectives began an investigation into the incident and located a witness who observed Brady and a 17 year old juvenile male enter the home. Detectives also learned that Brady and a 17 year old juvenile female returned to the home several hours later and committed a second burglary removing additional property from the home. Detectives conducted search warrants at the home of Brady and the 17 year old female and recovered stolen property including the stolen firearm.

Zachary Brady was arrested on May 15<sup>th</sup> and charged with the below offenses. He was arraigned through JP Court and released on \$40,000 unsecured bond.

Additional warrants for the two juveniles are forthcoming.
