SUBJECT: New Castle Man Arrested for Trespass and Peeping

Newark Police have arrested 55 year old Cory Disabatino, of New Castle, following an early morning peeping tom incident on October 17th, 2013 in the unit block of Benny Street and 100 block of South Chapel Street in the City of Newark.

At approximately 1:00am, members of the NPD Street Crimes Unit observed a suspicious male lurking in the rear of two homes in the 100 block of South Chapel Street. The suspicious male disappeared while the officers were attempting to locate him in the rear yard. A search was initiated including officers from Newark PD, UDPD and a K9 team from NCCPD. While searching for the male, an NPD officer was contacted by two residents of a home in the unit block of Benny Street who reported that a male, with the same description as the subject observed by the Street Crimes Unit, had just peered into rear windows of their home.

While conducting a search for the suspect, a UDPD officer spotted the male on South Chapel Street near Wyoming Road. The male, who was identified as Cory Disabatino, was taken into custody without incident and positively identified as the subject observed in the rear of the homes on Benny Street and South Chapel Street.

Disabatino was arrested on the below charges, arraigned through JP Court #11, and released on \$400 unsecured bail.
