**SUBJECT: NPD Investigating Suspicious Incident** 

On January 29<sup>th</sup> at approximately 3:15am, a 24 year-old female contacted a University of Delaware public works employee near Orchard Road and asked for a ride. The employee stated that he couldn't provide her with a ride and the female left the area. The employee then contacted the University of Delaware Police Department (UDPD). UDPD then contacted the female near the Park N Shop. The female told the UDPD officer of a robbery that allegedly occurred near the Super 8 motel and the UDPD officer contacted NPD.

The female told NPD she didn't wish to file a report and told various accounts of what happened. At this time, NPD is still investigating to determine if a robbery actually occurred. A subsequent press release will follow if warranted.
