SUBJECT: University of Delaware Student Arrested for Assault

On February 7th at approximately 11:30pm, Newark Police responded to 10 Center Street due to a large fight inside the apartment complex. Upon their arrival, officers observed a large crowd leaving the area. Multiple victims advised that a male with dreadlocks, later identified as <expunged>, assaulted them after <expunged> was asked to leave the party. <expunged> was not on scene when officers arrived.

On February 8th, <expunged> turned himself into NPD. He was released after posting \$1,100 secured bond.

Defendant: <expunged>

Charges: Assault 2nd Degree
2 counts Assault 3rd Degree
Criminal Trespass
Criminal Mischief

The three victims were University of Delaware male students - ages 20, 20 and 22. Two victims had minor injuries, and the 22 year-old had his top front teeth dislocated.

The Newark Police Department affirms that all defendants are presumed innocent until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt.
