## SUBJECT OF PRESS RELEASE Bank Robbery Wells Fargo South College Avenue

On Saturday June 20, 2015 at approximately 9:22 a.m., the Newark Police responded to the Wells Fargo Bank located at 622 South College Avenue for a bank robbery that had just occurred. The suspect walked up to a teller and presented a note demanding money. The bank teller turned over an undisclosed amount of cash. The suspect fled the area on foot in an unknown direction.

The suspect was described as a black male, 5'06" to 5'08" tall, medium build, 30-40 years old, wearing a gray hooded sweatshirt, a dark baseball hat, dark shorts, white socks with black and white sneakers.

Surveillance photos of the suspect are not available at this time.

The Newark Police Criminal Investigations Unit is continuing with this investigation.
