Fulton Bank Robbery

On Friday September 18, 2015 at approximately 12:20 p.m. the Newark Police responded to the Fulton Bank, located at 281 East Main Street, for a bank robbery. A male suspect entered the bank and passed a note demanding money from the tellers. No weapons were displayed. The suspect fled the bank after receiving an undisclosed amount of cash.

The suspect is described as black male, 6'00" tall, wearing a black button up shirt, blue/gray pants, black shoes and a black hat.

The Newark Police Criminal Investigations Division are currently investigating this case. No additional details are available at this time.
