#### **Newark Police Department Investigating Strong-Arm Robbery – UPDATE ARREST**

**September 23, 2016** – Newark Police Detectives have arrested Derrick Hudson Jr. (20) and Lewis Henderson (23) for the, August 17, 2016, robbery of a 28 year-old male University of Delaware that occurred August 17, 2016, on Thorn Lane, Newark, DE.

After an extensive investigation Newark Police Detectives were able to identify Derrick Hudson and Lewis Henderson as the perpetrators of this robbery. On September 22, 2016, Hudson was arrested, without incident at his residence in New Castle, DE. Henderson was arrested without incident near his residence on September 23, 2016. Both Hudson and Henderson were arraigned and committed to the Howard R. Young Correctional Institution.

**Newark Police Department Investigating Strong-Arm Robbery**

August 17, 2016 – Newark Police are investigating a strong-arm robbery that occurred on August 17<sup>th</sup> at approximately 1:10 a.m. on the unit block of Thorn Lane. The victim, a 28 year-old male University of Delaware student, was walking with his bicycle when two black male suspects approached him from both sides and assaulted him. The suspects stole his backpack, containing paper notebooks and a Dell Inspiron 7000 series computer, and then fled eastbound on foot. The victim was treated by EMS and transported to Christiana Emergency Room for further evaluation and is currently in stable condition.
