

WEEKLY REPORT

On November 10th, officers from the Street Crimes Unit arrested a 19 year old female for prostitution. The female, who resides in Baltimore, was working out of a Newark hotel room. When officers attempted to place the female under arrest she physically resisted. The female was charged with prostitution, hindering a police officer, and possession of marijuana.

The Newark Police Department has been allocated funds for driving under the influence enforcement to participate in the Delaware Department of Highway Safety "December Safe Family Holiday". To date this year, the Department of Highway Safety has funded three prior checkpoints that were worked by over 100 police officers from 28 different police agencies including Newark. The checkpoints have resulted in 47 DUI arrests and numerous others for seatbelt and cell phone violations, several wanted persons and other criminal/traffic offenses.

On November 15th, Corporal Robert Sharpe and his K-9 "Kody", were presented with the Hero Animal of the Year Award by the Delaware Veterinary Medical Association at a luncheon ceremony. Corporal Sharpe and Kody won the award for their successful track of two missing people this year. One was a suicidal female and one an autistic 11 year old boy. Congratulations to Cpl. Sharpe and Kody.

On November 16th, Deputy Manager Haines, Chief Tiernan, City Solicitor Herron and the two Deputy Police Chiefs met to discuss the initial planning for the court security initiative.
