**SUBJECT: Underage Party Results in 31 Arrests for Alcohol Violations**

On Saturday November 15 at 11:00 p.m. the Newark Police Department received a complaint of a loud party in the 200 block of Wilshire Lane, Newark. Responding officers were allowed entry to the house and saw an obvious party scene with a large quantity of alcoholic beverages. Numerous people were found hiding in the basement.

After identifying everyone present, it was determined that no one in the house was of legal drinking age. The investigation revealed that the adult residents were out of town, but their three teenage children were among the people inside the house.

31 people were arrested for Underage Consumption of Alcohol. Of those arrested, eleven were 19 years of age. They are:
