SUBJECT: Brett Griffin Update

The Newark Police Department has been made aware of the results of the autopsy performed on Brett Griffin, the University of Delaware student who died on November 8. State law prohibits the Newark Police Department from disclosing information contained in the autopsy report.

The Newark Police Department's investigation into the events surrounding Mr. Griffin's death is still active and remains on-going. Since the case is still being actively investigated, it is premature to comment on any findings to date or the potential final results.
