SUBJECT: Two Arrested in Commercial Burglaries

The Newark Police Department announces the arrests of two juveniles for their involvement in two burglaries which occurred on November 29, 2008. At 5:09 a.m. officers responded to a burglary alarm activation at the Bike Line located at 212 East Main Street, Newark. The officers found that a window had been broken, allowing entry into the business. Two bicycles, valued at \$299.95 and \$ 359.95, were stolen from inside.

While investigating that incident and conducting a search of the area, officers discovered a broken window at the East End Café located at 270 East Main Street. It was determined entry had also been made to that establishment, and that four bottles of liquor, collectively valued at \$100, had been stolen.

An anonymous tip led to the identification of the first suspect. The identity of the second suspect was learned through the continuation of the investigation. Both were charged with two counts each of Burglary 3rd Degree, Conspiracy 2nd Degree, Theft, and Criminal Mischief.

Defendant #1 is a 16 year-old male of the Possum Park Apartments, 630 Capital Trail, Newark. He was committed in default of \$6,100 bond.

Defendant #2 is a 14 year-old male of the unit block of Kullen Drive, Brookside, Newark. He was committed in default of \$13,000 bond.
