City Manager's Highlights

1. Items for newsletters:

a. Free Water for a Year!

As part of a federal regulation to control lead and copper in all water systems, the City is required to inventory the water distribution system materials in order to identify and remove any lead components from our water system. Residents and water customers are asked to complete a short survey for the chance to win 1 of 4 prizes of free water for one year, with a value up to \$1000! Public Works

1. Curb work on East Park Place will continue into the week of June 26, expected to finish up on or about June 30, weather dependent. Milling and paving operations will follow but have not been scheduled at this time. When Park Place is completed, the construction crew will be moving to West Chestnut Hill Road for some drainage work at Del Grove Ave.
2. DeIDOT contractor has closed southbound South College between Delaware Avenue and Amstel Avenue for a storm sewer repair. The work is progressing as planned and should be complete by July 21.
3. DeIDOT will be reconstructing the Library Avenue and 273/Main Street Intersection beginning on July 7. Detours and closures will be necessary to complete this work in a timely fashion. The work will be 24/7 and a noise waiver has been issued for the work. Message boards will be deployed at least 10 days in advance of the work. Please use caution and plan for delays.
