SUBJECT: 7-11 Robbery

On Monday March 30, 2009, around 4:40 a.m., the suspect entered the 7-11 at 235 East Delaware Avenue. He walked behind the service counter, displayed a silver knife to the store employee, and demanded money. The clerk opened the register and the suspect removed the cash from the drawer. The suspect also grabbed a few packs of cigarettes, and then left the store. He was last seen walking toward South Chapel Street.

The victim, a 20 year-old male employee, was not injured.

The suspect is described as a black male, 20 to 30 years of age, 5' 10' to 6' tall, weighing 160 to 180 lbs, clean shaven. He wore an orange hooded sweatshirt and blue jeans. The jeans have a design on the rear pocket that is enlarged in attached photo #4.
