SUBJECT: Armed Street Robbery

On Thursday April 24 around 1:00 p.m., an armed robbery occurred on the service road behind the odd numbered houses on Madison Drive, where it abuts West Knoll Apartments. The victim was walking on the road when he was approached by the two suspects. One of the two showed a handgun and removed a duffel bag and cell phone from the victim.

The armed suspect is described as a light-skinned black male, 5' 9" tall, wearing a black shirt, blue jeans, and a lancet necklace.

The second suspect is a light-skinned black female with a pony tail, wearing a black hoodie and jeans.

The victim, a 36 year-old male, was not injured.
