SUBJECT: Indecent Exposure Arrest

On Friday July 3 around 9:00 p.m., an Indecent Exposure incident occurred in the parking lot of the College Square Shopping Center, Newark. The three victims were in their parked car when the suspect stopped along side of them in his White Chevrolet Impala with PA registration plate HDR3551. The driver of the Chevy had his pants down and his penis exposed. He remained parked next to the female victims for a period of time, drove away, and then circled around and returned, still exposing himself. Again, he remained for a period of time, then drove away.

While the responding police officer was speaking to the victims at the shopping center, the suspect returned. He saw the police vehicle and attempted to drive behind the buildings, but was intercepted by the officer. He was positively identified by the victims and was taken into custody. He is:

He was charged with three counts of Indecent Exposure 2nd Degree and was committed to the Howard Young Correctional Facility in default of \$750.00 bond. If released, he is to have no contact with the victims or the College Square Shopping Center.

The victims were three females, ages 32, 29, and 20, all from the New Castle area.
