SUBJECT: Recommendation to Amend the 2023-2027 Capital Improvement Program Budget and

Award Contract No. 23-05 - 2023 Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Transition Plan

Improvements (CIP H2302)

BACKGROUND

Contract No. 23-05 provides various combinations of curb replacement, handicap ramp installations, and hot mix patching at 21 locations to install new or upgrade existing handicap curb ramps to meet current ADA standards. Similar to previous contracts, this contract includes ramps within City of Newark right of way and DelDOT right of way. The locations of the handicap ramps are identified on the attached exhibit for your reference.

BID PROCESS

The Purchasing Division advertised Contract 23-05 in <u>The News Journal</u> and posted the contract on the City website (<u>www.newarkde.gov/bids</u>) and delivered it via email to several vendors. On Tuesday, June 27, 2023, four (4) sealed bids were received via email or hand delivery and were opened shortly after the 2:00 p.m. deadline. The bidders were as follows:

CONTRACTOR EXPERIENCE

The lowest responsible bidder, G&M Concrete, LLC, has successfully performed similar improvements

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throughout the City and has successfully completed the city's 2021 and 2022 Sidewalk Improvement Program as well as several smaller projects at City Hall. The bid is \$61,025.00 lower than the next lowest bidder. This is a result of the contractor's ability to keep mobilization costs very low as they will be in the area completing other projects during the late summer and early fall. Staff is confident G&M Concrete has accounted for all items in the scope of work and has provided a reasonable and competitive bid for this contract.

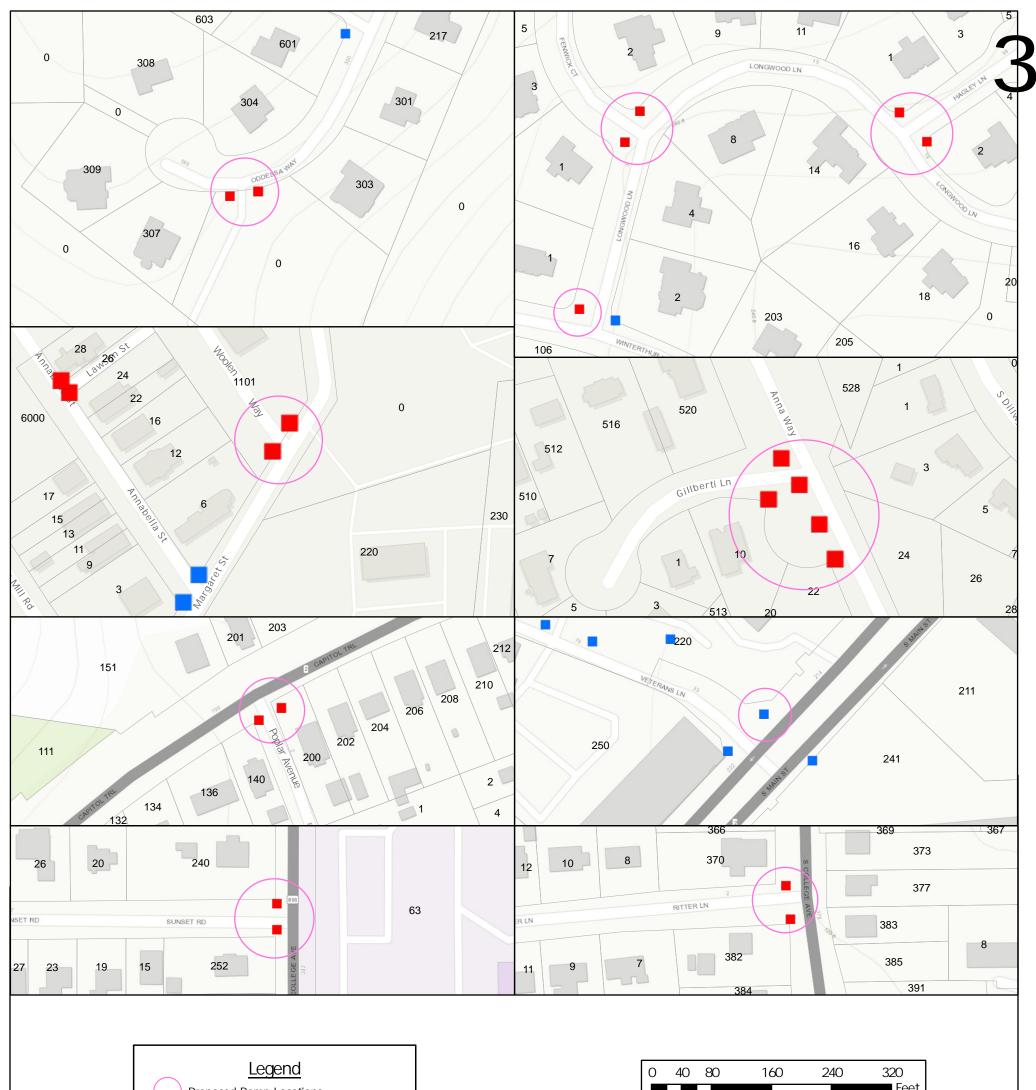

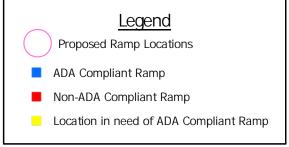

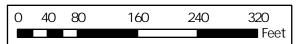
Since we have a plan in place to address non-compliant ramps and are successfully following the plan we are in compliance with the ADA requirements.
