1. Notice to Bidders

The sign-in sheet is attached. The purpose of this meeting was to provide an opportunity for prospective bidders to ask questions regarding the project. Provided below is a summary of the pertinent discussion items.

BIDDING ADMINISTRATION INFORMATION

- A. Sign In Sheet: The pre-bid meeting is non-mandatory. See attached sign-in sheet.
- B. Bid Opening: Tuesday October 24, 2023 at 2:00 pm.
- C. Addenda: An addendum will be issued to address questions and clarify issues discussed at the prebid meeting. The addendum will be emailed to all attendees listed on the sign-in sheet AND uploaded to the City of Newark's website.
- D. Questions: Submit questions regarding the bidding process via email to contracts@newark.de.us no later than 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, October 18, 2023.
 - Ethan Robinson, City of Newark, stated the maximum file size for submission is 25 MB. If the bidder receives an automated response after submission, the bidder should call the City to confirm receipt of bid submission.

SCOPE OF WORK

- A. Ten (10) Project Locations throughout the City of Newark.
 - Adam stated work areas are within either City or State right-of-way, bidders are responsible to visit project areas prior to submitting bid.



- B. Work includes installation of:
 - Ductile iron pipe and fittings
 - Polyethylene pipe wrap (V-Bio)
 - Valves
 - Fittings
 - Restraint couplings
 - Wet tap sleeves and valves
 - Valve boxes
 - Water service materials and fittings
 - Fire hydrants
 - Horizontal directional drill
 - Restoration of road and sidewalk
- C. Anticipated Notice to Proceed is January 2024. Contract duration is 300-days. Liquidated damages are set to \$500 per day.
- D. The City may elect to remove any of the project locations for any reason. Bid price for all locations to be awarded cannot be modified if locations are removed.
- E. Unit pricing shall include all incidental costs necessary to complete the scope of work item. This includes, but is not limited to, equipment, manpower, profit, overhead, materials, maintenance of traffic, restoration, etc.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWER SESSION

Question 1:	Is V-Bio wrap still required for the horizontal directional drill section? Does the City/Engineer have experience with securing the wrap?	
Response 1:	V-Bio wrap is required. It is recommended that the contractor tape continuously.	
Question 2:	Have DelDOT permits been acquired?	
Response 2:	2: Not at this time. Coordination with DelDOT is in progress.

21. LIABILITY INSURANCE

- A. The Contractor shall at all times maintain and keep in force such insurance as will protect him from claims under Worker's Compensation Acts, and also such insurance as will protect him and the owner from any such claims for damages for personal injuries, including death, which may arise from operations under this contract, whether such operations be by the Contractor or by any Subcontractor or anyone directly or indirectly employed by any of them.
- B. The Contractor shall be required to provide Workers' Compensation (WC)/Employer's Liability (EL) coverage with limits of insurance not less than:

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$1,000,000 Per Accident
$1,000,000 Per Illness, Employee
$1,000,000 Per Illness, Aggregate
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The Contractor shall be required to provide Contractors Professional Liability coverage with limits of insurance not less than:

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$2,000,000 Per Claim
$2,000,000 Per Aggregate
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The Contractor shall be required to provide Umbrella/Excess Liability coverage with limits of insurance not less than:

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$4,000,000 Each Occurrence
$4,000,000 Aggregate
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The Contractor shall be required to provide Commercial General Liability (CGL) coverage with limits of insurance not less than:

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$2,000,000 Each Occurrence Limit
$2,000,000 Personal & Advertising Injury Limit
$3,000,000 Annual Aggregate Limit
$3,000,000 Products-Completed Operations Limit
$1,000,000 Business Auto Liability Limit (Owned, Hired, & Non-Owned Autos)
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The Contractor, The City of Newark (Owner), JMT (Engineer), and all other parties required of the Contractor shall be included as insured on the CGL, using additional insured endorsements providing coverage as broad as the coverage provided for the named insured Subcontractor.
