

Precautions for Portable Meth Lab Waste

There have been instances of mobile meth labs in the area, so please review the information below that may be signs of a portable meth lab:

Unusual strong odors like ammonia (smells like cat urine)

Strong odor of Acetone (smells like nail polish remover)

Unusual amount of discarded bottles, coffee filters, gas cans, jugs, cheesecloth, duct tape, portable hot plates and chemicals as described below

Glassware or plastic soda bottles with rubber tubing attached

(There may be a brown liquid substance in the containers that have an unusual odor.)

Dead plants, grass in the area of discarded materials

Common chemicals associated with meth labs:

Acetone

Rubbing Alcohol

Battery Acid

Bleach

Drain Cleaner

Lithium Batteries

Over the counter cold pills (ephedrine & pseudoephedrine)

Fertilizer

Iodine



If you suspect a meth lab or associated items:

Leave the site immediately

Contact the police

Do not touch anything

Do not open boxes or containers
